As a result of the corona crisis and its effect on the continuity of art (book) fairs, presentation costs, if awarded, will only be transferred after signed confirmation by the applicant stating that the fair will definitively take place. This confirmation should be submitted no earlier than 4 weeks before the start of the presentation. A further condition is that the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs has to clear international travel to the country in question. The awarded presentation costs will be reserved for a maximum of 12 months. The presentation costs will be transferred no earlier than 4 and at least 2 weeks before the opening of the event. This measure does not influence the payment of awarded production costs.
