



Authorisation form for non-Dutch organisations

To submit a grant application to the Mondriaan Fund, an organisation must specify an account holder. The account holder manages the account on behalf of the organisation and signs applications and final justification reports. Because the account holder signs in person, he or she must have formal authority to represent the organisation or, in other words, have signing authority.

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* 'Authorised person' means: a person who, on the basis of the organisation's official articles of association or registration documents, is formally authorised to represent the organisation and perform legal acts on its behalf. In most cases, this is a director, chairperson or other legal representative appointed by the board of directors who has signing authority under the articles of association. This authority must be proven by an official document (e.g. the articles of association, an extract from the business register or a resolution of the board of directors) which explicitly includes the name(s) of the person(s) who has/have signing authority.
